A new path and stile linking the cemetery to the National Trust's Smallcombe Wood has created a circular walk over an outstanding landscape with spectacular views



A sloping, slippery unofficial track led into the wood above, via a gap in the unstable wall where it had already fallen.







The surrounding walls were first rebuilt incorporating a stone stile.

Then a new path with stone risers and stone gravel steps were built ensuring a far safer route for visitors and dog walkers.
